All Staff (Including Shielded Employees): Potential to Become Infected by Airborne Particles	Chronic respiratory illness resulting from inhalation of Virus	4 X 5 20	<ul> <li>Symptomatic isolation: An individual showing early symptoms (a continuous cough or a temperature of 37.8 degrees or higher, or a loss of or change in normal sense of taste or smell, should self-isolate for ten (10) days. This means that you must stay at home and NOT go into work or anywhere else.</li> <li>Household isolation: All residents of households are to enter self-isolation for fourteen (14) days if anyone in the household develops any of the early symptoms listed above. This means that the household must stay at home and NOT go into work or anywhere else.</li> <li>Take Guidance from your GP or 111</li> <li>Follow the latest advice issued by HM Government and adhere to local rules: HM Government advice is changing regularly and there are now local rules being applied.</li> <li>Follow the advice of NHS Test and Trace: If contacted to say that you have been in contact with somebody with COVID-19 YOU MUST FOLLOW THE INSTRUCTIONS GIVEN BY NHS TEST AND TRACE</li> <li>If you travel back from a country not on the corridor travel list (i.e. not exempt), you must self-isolate for fourteen (14) days. Staff Becoming Infected by Airborne Particles from Movement of People: Factory Units, Stores, Factory Rest Areas	Chronic respiratory illness resulting from inhalation of Virus	4 X 5 20	<ul> <li>Wearing task mandatory Moldex FFP3 2555 mask or Moldex 7005/6 mask with 9030 filters and gloves will guard against COVID-19</li> <li>Control access to the working area by ensuring those around you keep 2m distance if masks are not being worn (because task doesn't require it)</li> <li>Increase the frequency of hand washing and surface cleaning</li> <li>Foremen to continually review factory processes to allow people to work further apart from each other</li> <li>Everyone to be aware that social distancing applies to all parts of the work environment, not just places where people spend most of their time, but also entrances and exits</li> <li>During briefings allow 2m distance between each other</li> <li>Hold meetings outdoors or in factory units where distancing can be achieved (not the training room or an individual's office for more than 2 people)</li> <li>Disposable cups provided in vending area - stops transfer of coronavirus</li> <li>All staff asked to read and sign "Coronavirus - Return to Work Instructions" 22.04.2020</li> <li>All staff asked to read and sign "Coronavirus - COVID-19 (reminder)" 07.05.2020</li> <li>All staff asked to read and sign "COVID-19 UPDATE" 23.09.2020</li> <li>Daily temperature checks of staff, daily checking of 2m distancing/wearing of masks</li> </ul>	1 X 5 <b>5</b>
